The Challenge

- Run for Love will be an extreme physical challenge across often remote and challenging terrain.
- Run for Love is not a formal, marked race with water stations and medical support. Runners and riders must be able to navigate for themselves and be entirely self-sufficient.
- Run for Love is a community endeavor. You will be part of a team of runners and riders taking on the challenge together. You must look out for and look after those on the road with you. They will do the same for you. This is not a race. It is a self-supported journey. But we are taking on the challenge together.
- This Road Book sets out details of the Stage 1 route that runners will follow, together with start times and locations for each day.
- Nonetheless the journey will bring unforeseen challenges which will sculpt the route.
- If you acknowledge and understand the above, and want to take part in an adventure for an amazing cause, then please read on....

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PRACTICAL INFORMATION



Registration & Costs

You can [register for Stage 1 here](#).

The Registration Fee for Stage 1 is **£300**.

The Registration Fee is paid in two instalments. £100 is paid on sign up as a non-refundable deposit. The balance (£200) is paid no later than 1 May.

The Registration Fee includes:

- Logistical support from a support car with 2x Run for Love crew (including a physio)
- Bag transfer each day from the run start to the finish point.
- 6 nights accommodation (from 29 June until 6th July (i.e. inc. Arrival Day and Departure Day))
- Transport from Sarajevo airport to the Stage 1 start point (Busovoca)
- Daily TRIBE Fuel Pack
- Run For Love t-shirt



Registration & Costs

The Registration Fee does not include:

- Transport to / from start and finish points (eg flights to Sarajevo)
- Insurance (see below)
- Kit
- Meals (lunch & dinner).
- Any extended accommodation (ie any additional nights if you arrive early / extend your trip)
- Any other sundry expenses

It's important to understand that Run for Love is not an organised race. It is a community coming together for a charity challenge. The registration fee not intended to be an "entry fee". It covers Accommodation and Support Car "costs" that will be shared equally at cost by all runners joining Stage 1.



Travel & Medical

• Travel

- Runners are responsible for booking their own transport to and from the Start (Sarajevo) and Finish (Zagreb) of Stage 1.
- For those flying in from the UK, we suggest arriving the day before the Run for Love starts and taking the following flights:
- Outbound: Croatia Airlines. Dept: 29 June, 10:50 LHR. Arrive. 15:45 Sarajevo.
- Home: British Airways. Dept: 6 July, 12:30 Zagreb. Arrive 14:00 LHR.
- NB: The Run for Love team will organise transport from Sarajevo Airport to the start point (Busovaca, 25 miles north of Sarajevo) on 29 June.

• Insurance & Medical

- Run for Love II is an extreme physical challenge and runners must take out adequate travel and medical insurance.
- For the avoidance of doubt, there is no insurance policy in place for participants taking part in the event.
- Lucy - an experienced endurance sports physiotherapist - is part of the Run for Love Support and Medical team. She will be there to assist runners who have injuries. There will be no paramedic, ambulance or doctor on the trip.



Accommodation

• Accommodation

- Accommodation costs are included in the Registration Fee.
- We will be running through remote parts of Bosnia and Croatia. In some towns where we are staying there is only one hotel. We have booked all the rooms in these hotels, but runners will be sharing in 2s, 3s, 4s, or 5s. The hotels will be basic, but will provide a welcome and safe place to rest each night.
- On night 6 we will be staying in a camp. This will be a series of large communal tents set up for us near the Stari Gaj national park. Camping equipment will be provided to runners. It will be simple, but in a beautiful setting.

On the Road

- **ROADS.** Although we have deliberately picked quiet rural roads, we will be running on public roads which at times we will be sharing with traffic. Roads will not be closed for Run for Love, and runners must be road safe. We will be running on a mix of tarmac roads, dirt roads and trails.
- **NAVIGATING.** We will be sharing a Strava map of each day's route and giving an evening briefing of the route the night before each run. Although we will endeavour to stick together (and runners will buddy up), runners must be comfortable running on their own and navigating their own route.
- **SUPPORT.** There will be a number of Run for Love Run Captains in the group - these are experienced ultra runners who will be helping to guide the run. There will be a support car following the group, with two Run for Love team members (including a physio), carrying basic first aid and TRIBE nutrition.
- **CHECKPOINTS.** There will be 2-3 checkpoints on route each day, where runners will stop to regroup and refuel. Runners must carry adequate water and food in a day pack to stay hydrated and energised between checkpoints, in at times extreme heat. We will circulate a required day pack kit list before the run.
- **FOOD & WATER.** Runners will be given a TRIBE Fuel Pack each day. This will include a mix of energy and recovery products for the day's run. There will be additional nutrition and water in the Run for Love support car, but runners are responsible for carrying what they need for each day. (Each night we will brief on stops where runners can pick up supplies on route the following day).
- **TIME ON THE ROAD.** Runners should be mentally and physically prepared for 7-9 hours a day on the road.

Thursday 29 June 2017 - Arrive in Sarajevo

The plan is for runners flying from the UK to get the following flight:

- Croatia Airlines. Dept: 29 June, 10:50 LHR. Arrive. 15:45 Sarajevo.

We will then take a coach from Sarajevo Airport to the start point of the run (Busovaca) 20 miles north. We will organise a welcome supper for all runners and stay there that night, ready for the first day of the run in the morning.

Runners taking different flights may either meet us at the airport for the coach, or meet us at Busovaca (Hotel Tiss).



STAGE 1 – DAY 1 – 31 MILES

Friday 30 June 2017 - Sarajevo (Busovača) to Šišava

Day 1: A tough start to RfL climbing to the snow capped mountains at Sisava

DAY HIGHLIGHTS:

- Setting off from Busovača, 20 miles north of Sarajevo, into the Vlašić Mountains.
- Following the River Lašva before starting a beautiful climb into the centre of Bosnia.
- The climb into the ski resort of Šišava will be tough but beautiful.
- Country Number: 1!!

LOCATION: Busovača

START TIME: 06:30





STAGE 1 - DAY 2 - 35 MILES

Saturday 1 July 2017 - Šišava to Mrkonjic Grad

Day 2: A tough, slowly ascending day from 1420ft to 3946ft and then downhill into picturesque Jajce

DAY HIGHLIGHTS:

- A maximum altitude of 4,895ft, the descent from Šišava will show some awesome views of Jajce.
- The breathtaking Pliva Waterfalls in Jajce will give a great backdrop for a well-earned break.
- Running along the beautiful Lake Plivsko Jerzero and River Vrbas that feeds the Pliva Waterfalls.

Sunday 2 July 2017 - Mrkonjic Grad to Banja Luka

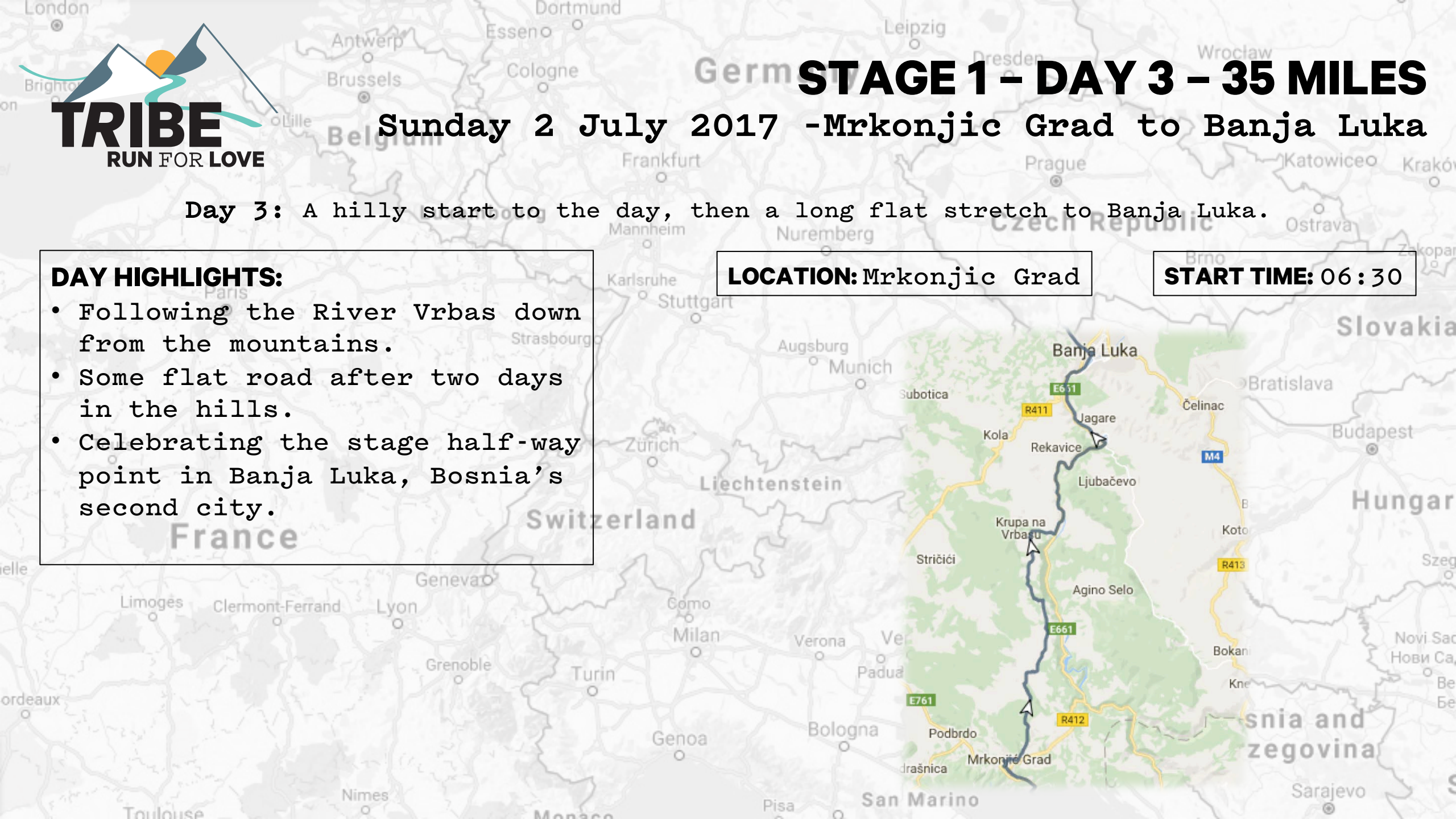
Day 3: A hilly start to the day, then a long flat stretch to Banja Luka.

Monday 3 July 2017 - Banja Luka to Prijedor

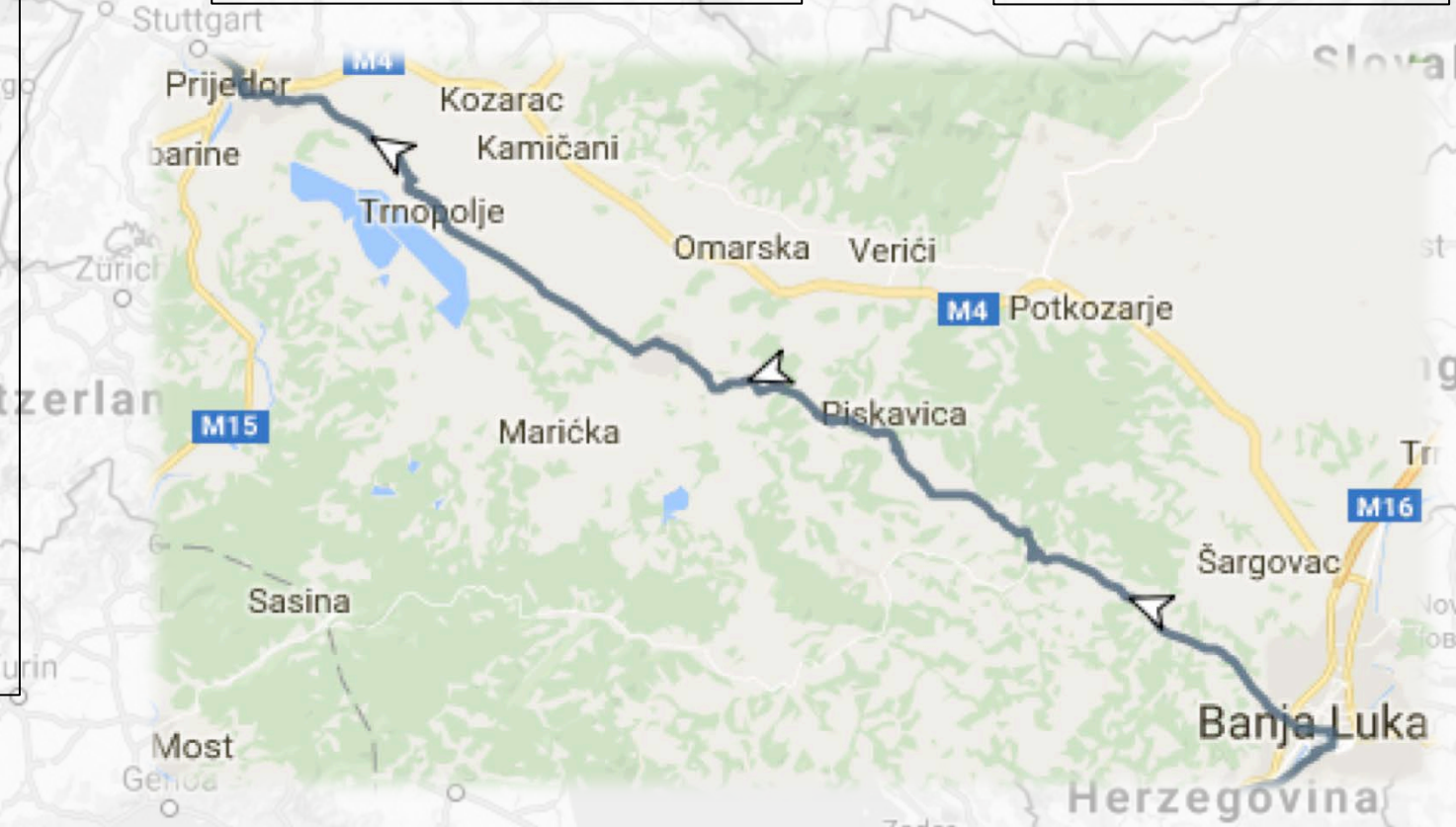
Day 4: The calm before the 44 mile storm tomorrow.

Tuesday 4 July 2017 - Prijedor to Taboriste

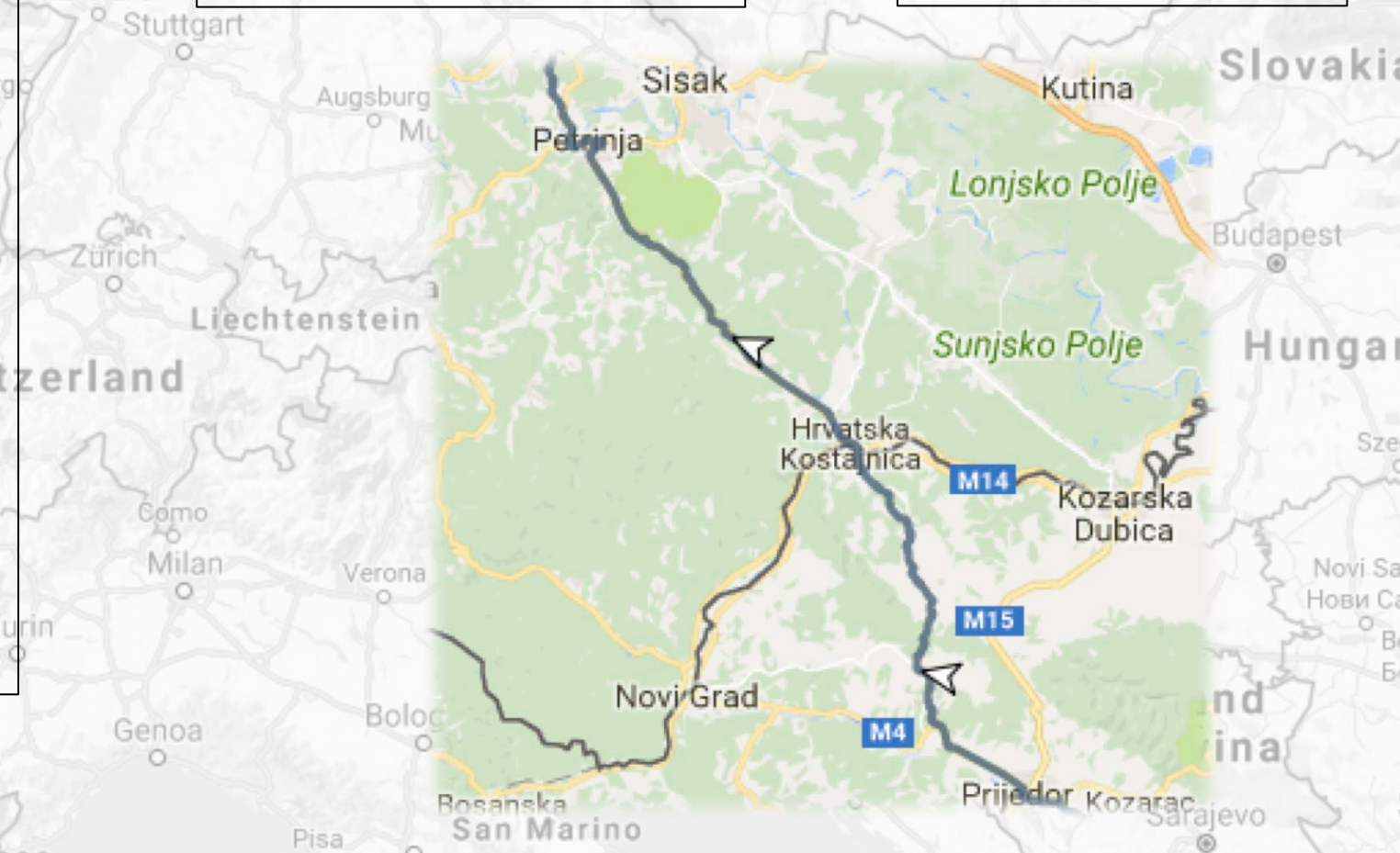
Day 5: A monster day, seeing us cross to Croatia and make it to the TRIBE camp.

Wednesday 5 July 2017 - Sisak to Zagreb

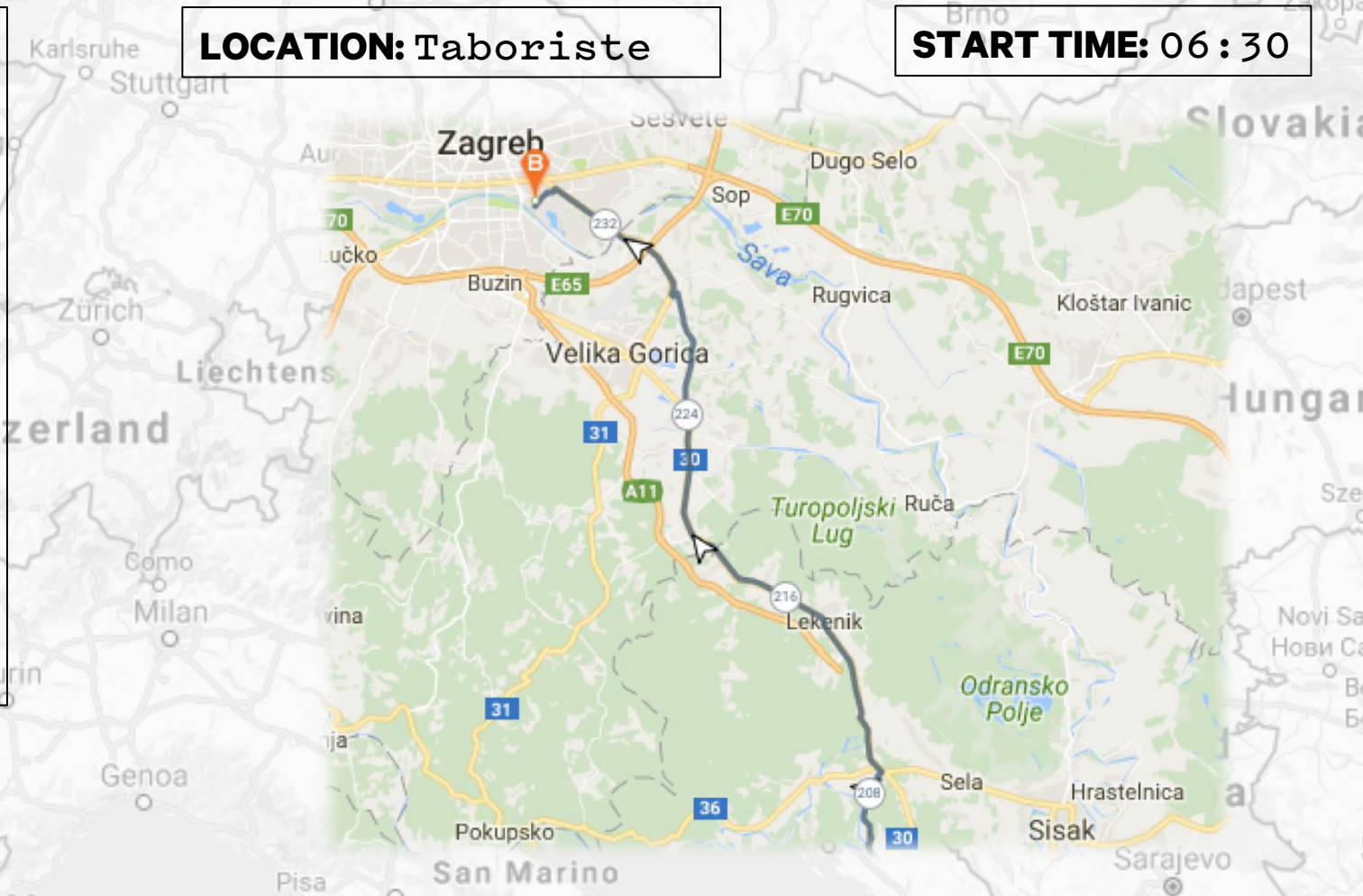
Day 6: Final stretch into Zagreb and a well earned celebration

TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. Definitions

- 1.1 “Associated Parties” means the Event Organiser, its officers, employees, suppliers and/or sponsors and/or persons for whom it is answerable.
- 1.2 “Conditions” means these terms and conditions of entry for the Event.
- 1.3 “Entry Fee” means the price of entry into the Event as set out in the Entry Form.
- 1.4 “Entry Form” means the website pages which must be completed in order to participate in the Event.
- 1.6 “Event” means Run for Love.
- 1.7 “Event Category” means the different race categories or streams within the Event.
- 1.8 “Event Information” means any and all information provided by the Event Organiser in relation to the Event.
- 1.9 “Event Organiser” means Everyday Adventures Limited, a company registered in England & Wales with company registration number 09286289.
- 1.10 “Online Entry Portal” means the Event Organiser’s online registration system participants must use in order to apply, register and pay for their entry to the Event.
- 1.11 “Participant” means the person named on the Entry Form who will be participating in the Event.
- 1.12 “Reserved Entry” means the Participant’s entry that has been reserved (either deferred from the previous year or otherwise) for the following year subject to the Participant completing an Entry Form and paying the applicable Entry Fee for such event within the stipulated time limits for such Event.
- 1.13 “Withdrawal” means once the Participant has received written (via email or post) confirmation from the Event Organiser acknowledging the Participant’s request to withdraw from the Event.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

2. Acceptance of Conditions

These Conditions shall apply in place of, and prevail over, any terms or conditions (whether or not in or inconsistent with these Conditions) contained or referred to in any documentation submitted by the Participant or in correspondence or elsewhere or implied by trade custom, practice or course of dealing. A variation of these Conditions is only valid if the Event Organiser gives notice to the Participant in writing in any official Event material or correspondence prior to the Event (including via email). The Participant shall be deemed to have accepted these Conditions upon completion of the Entry Form.

3. Participation

3.1 The Participant agrees that he/she is responsible for their own fitness to take part in the Event, and will consult a doctor prior to the Event. The Participant acknowledges that participation in the Event is physically strenuous and entirely at the Participant's own risk. It is acknowledged that participation in the Event will be physically demanding and the Participant is aware of the nature of the Event and associated medical and physical risks involved. It is further acknowledged that the Event is not an organised race but a self-supported journey: It is a community coming together for a charity challenge. The Participant confirms that he/she understands that the Event involves substantial and sustained physical exercise in remote areas and open roads (shared with traffic) and trails.

3.2 The Participant agrees that: (i) he/she is physically capable of competing in the Event; (ii) he/she shall be solely responsible for his/her actions; and (iii) the Event Organiser, its officers, employees, agents, affiliates, associated companies, sponsors or medical advisers are not responsible for any injury or illness that the Participant may suffer as a result of his/her participation in the Event (unless caused due to the negligence of the Event Organiser). The Participant accepts that, should any medical or physical condition arise prior to the Event which is likely to affect his/her ability to compete, the Participant will withdraw in accordance with these Conditions. The Participant acknowledges the exclusion of liability and indemnity provided in clause 6 of these Conditions.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

3.3 The Participant agrees to abide by all applicable rules and regulations of the Event and any relevant sporting governing bodies that may oversee the running of the Event. The Participant shall not be entitled to a refund of the Entry Fee if he or she is disqualified from the Event as a result of an infringement of these Conditions or any such rules and regulations. The Event Organiser and/or owners of the venue where the Event is conducted are also entitled to impose additional Event rules upon the Participant from time to time which will be provided or made available to the Participant and will form part of these Conditions. Any relevant rules and regulations may be obtained from the Event website or upon request to the Event Organiser.

3.4 The Participant must complete the appropriate registration process (if any) on the dates and at the times as instructed in the Event Information, which will be issued by the Event Organiser before the Event.

3.5 The Event Organiser may introduce cut of times as it sees fit as part of the Event rules, being limits on the time taken to complete sections of the Event (as decided by the Event Organiser at its discretion) to ensure the safe and proper running of the Event. Consequently, participants may be instructed to withdraw from the race in accordance with imposed cut-off times. The Participant understand that if they contravene the decisions or advice of the Event Organiser's staff, nominated representatives, and contractors and those of the Event Organiser or undertake independent activities during the Event, it will terminate all protection and duty of care from those parties.

3.6 The Event Organiser reserves the right at any time to remove the Participant from the Event or prevent the Participant participating in the Event if, in the Event Organiser's sole discretion, it considers such action necessary for safety reasons or the proper enjoyment of the Event by other participants or for any other reasonable reason.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

3.7 While the Event Organiser takes every care with the staging of the Event, the Participant acknowledges that no insurance is taken out by the Event Organiser on the Participant's behalf. Therefore, any and all insurance (including personal accident and personal items insurance) is his or her sole responsibility and the Event Organiser requires that all Participants take out comprehensive travel and medical insurance. In particular, the Participant acknowledges that any Withdrawal on medical grounds will not entitle them to a refund etc. other than as detailed at Clause 5 below and any insurance to cover this is their own responsibility.

3.8 The Event Organiser will email all communications to the email address provided by the Participant upon his/her original application. The Event Organiser shall not be held responsible for any computer malfunctions or other technical anomalies that may occur in the process of sending out such email communications that may lead to failure of receipt by the Participant. To ensure receipt of all Event information, it is the sole responsibility of the Participant to ensure they provide the Event Organiser with the correct email address and postal address and to inform the Event Organiser of any changes to these prior to the Event within the time limits specified in these Conditions.

3.9 The minimum age of entry for the Event is 18 years old as at the date of the Event.

3.10 All decisions and rulings by the Event Organiser, its employees and its agents are considered final. Accordingly, the Participant will comply with all Event rules and all instructions and guidelines given by stewards, marshals, and safety personnel. The Participant acknowledges and agrees that the Event Organiser will organise and run the Event and will have sole authority and be the final arbiter on all decisions relating to the safety, running and organisation of the Event, the rules of the Event, the timings/ finish times and the placings.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

3.11 These Conditions and the entry into the Event are personal to the Participant and he/she may not assign any of his/her rights or obligations under this Agreement without the prior written consent of the Event Organiser. The Participant represents and warrants that the entry is purchased for personal use only, that it will not be donated free of charge or otherwise given away (other than by a Charity for Charity Participants as applicable), and that it is not purchased as part of any form of business or commercial activity (save as expressly authorised by the Event Organiser), and in particular, that the entry may not be resold or offered for resale by anyone whether at a premium or otherwise and may not be used for advertising, promotion use as a prize (including in competitions and sweepstakes), travel packages, or for any other trade purposes, without the prior written consent of the Event Organiser. For the avoidance of doubt, donation, give away, resale or attempted resale is grounds for seizure or cancellation without refund or other compensation.

3.12 The Participant acknowledges and accepts that circumstances concerning an Event may change from time to time for reasons out of the Event Organiser's reasonable control or otherwise, without the Event Organiser incurring any liability and without any rights to Withdrawal being accrued by the Participant other than set out in clause 5 below. By way of example, and for illustration purposes only, car parking arrangements and the exact route of any part of the Event may change but such changes/issues will not allow the Participant to withdraw and nor will the Event Organiser be deemed liable except as otherwise set out herein.

3.13 As a continuing condition of entry each Participant shall ensure that, for the duration of the Event:

3.13.1 he/she follows the Event route as signed/instructed at all times, and does not deviate from the official Event route;

3.13.2 he/she will provide their own safety approved cycle helmet which is to be worn at all times when cycling;

3.13.3 his/her road bike is in good condition and is appropriate and roadworthy for the cycle Stages of the Event;

3.13.4 he/she acknowledges the recommended kit list of the Event, in accordance with the Event Stage, and is responsible for bringing appropriate clothing and equipment to participate in the Event;

TERMS & CONDITIONS

3.13.5 he/she participates responsibly and safely and abides by all Event rules and regulations notified by the Event Organiser;

3.13.6 where applicable, he/she shall hold valid and proper legal identification documents (e.g. passport including visa (where necessary)) required for travel within Europe; and

3.13.7 he/she holds suitable personal and travel insurance which covers, amongst other things, loss or damage to your bike and personal belongings, helicopter rescue, and treatment and repatriation costs in the event of injury/medical emergency (and will produce evidence of the same to the Event Organiser upon request).

3.14 The Participant agrees to abide by all road rules at all times and to run and/or cycle safely at all times.

4. Bookings and Payments

4.1 In consideration for being granted the right to participate, the Participant must pay the Entry Fee by no later than the closing date set out on the Entry Form.

4.2 The Participant shall complete the Entry Form online and submit it together with payment of the Entry Fee online in accordance with the Event Organisers' website.

4.3 The Participant shall not be eligible or entitled to participate in the Event until full payment of the Entry Fee has been received by the Event Organiser and the Parental Consent Form has been returned (as appropriate). No payment shall be deemed to have been received until the Event Organiser has received cleared funds.

5. Withdrawal, Cancellations or Alterations

5.1 This clause 5 shall not apply to Charity Participants whose places are the property of the Charity. All cancellations, refunds or withdrawals by Charity Participants must be taken up directly with their designated Charity. No refunds (mentioned in this clause 5) shall be made directly to any individual Charity Participant in any case.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

5.2 The Event Organiser operates a fourteen (14) day cooling off period. Accordingly, the Participant is entitled to cancel his/her application to participate provided the Event Organiser receives written notice of cancellation within fourteen (14) days of payment of the Entry Fee (payment being deemed made for the purposes of this clause 5.2 by clicking on the make payment link on the secure payment webpage). During this fourteen (14) day period the Participant is able to cancel his/her entry and receive a full refund of the Entry Fee by emailing team@wearetribe.co. The notice must be received before the end of the 14 day cooling off period.

5.3 The Event Organiser reserves the right to alter the start time of the Event. In the event of a change of start time the Participant will be notified of the revised start time with as much notice as reasonably practicable. No refund in full or in part shall be made for any change in start time for an Event.

5.4 The Participant acknowledges that participant places are limited and payment of the Entry Fee and reservation of the place has an effect on logistics and the subscription for the Event. Accordingly, subject to clause 5.2 above, the Participant may withdraw from the Event at any time, subject to the following:

5.4.1 if the Participant withdraws from the Event he/she will receive no refund.

5.5 Notice of Withdrawal from the Event must be communicated by emailing team@wearetribe.co.

5.6 The Event Organiser reserves the right to amend the Event format, route or distance in their sole discretion or cancel the Event due to circumstances beyond its reasonable control or for any safety related reason. In the event of the Event being cancelled or changed for reasons that are beyond the Event Organiser's reasonable control - either before or during the Event - the participant will be liable to no refund and the Event Organiser will have no liability whatsoever arising from such cancellation.

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6. Event Organiser Responsibilities/Liability

6.1 Notwithstanding anything in these Conditions, the Event Organiser shall not be liable to the Participant for any liability in contract, tort (including negligence) or otherwise for any loss of business, revenue or profits, anticipated savings or wasted expenditure, loss or damage of or to personal equipment belonging to the Participant or any indirect or consequential loss or damage whatsoever (notwithstanding that such loss was within the contemplation of the parties at the date of submitting the Entry Form) arising out of the Participant taking part in the Event or any other matter arising under these Conditions nor for an aggregate amount greater than the Entry Fee paid by the Participant. Without limiting the foregoing, the Event Organiser will not be liable for any actions of any spectators or other third parties unless otherwise set out herein.

6.2 Accordingly the Participant hereby expressly and irrevocably renounces, for him/herself, heirs and successors in title the right to any recourse or claims whatsoever against the Associated Parties as a result of any kind of physical, mental or other loss or damage of whatsoever nature (including any loss of earnings, profits, or pain and suffering) suffered by the Participant, directly or indirectly, or by his/her family or by any dependents and caused by an event in any way relating to the Participant's participation in Event, and the Participant hereby undertakes, for him/herself, heirs and successors in title to indemnify and hold harmless the Event Organiser, and the Associated Parties for any costs and/or amount, which they or any of them may be required to pay as a result of any aforesaid recourse or claim by whomsoever made. The Participant also agrees to indemnify the Event Organiser and the Associated Parties for any claim, actions, liabilities or losses resulting from any breach of the Participant's declarations above and/or the Participant's negligent acts or omissions and/or wilful misconduct.

6.3 Nothing in these Conditions shall exclude or limit the liability of the Event Organiser:

6.3.1 for death or personal injury caused by the Event Organiser's negligence;

6.3.2 for fraud or fraudulent misrepresentation; or

6.3.3 for any matter which it would be illegal for the Event Organiser to exclude or attempt to exclude liability.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

6.4 This clause 6 shall be read and construed and shall have effect subject to any limitation imposed by any applicable law.

7. Publicity and Results

7.1 The Participant irrevocably consents to:

7.1.1 his/her appearance in the Event being filmed, recorded, incorporated and exploited in whole or in part in any television programme, film, video or broadcast of whatever nature by all means and in all media and formats now or invented after the date of these Conditions by the Event Organiser and its Associated Parties; and

7.1.2 the use and reproduction by the Event Organiser and its Associated Parties of the Participant's name, likeness, appearance, Event times and photographs, films and recordings by all means and in all media for the purpose of advertising, publicity and otherwise in relation to the exploitation of the Event (and future events) and/or the promotion of the Event (and future events) and the commercial rights relating to the Event (and future events) provided that such use does not imply direct endorsement by the Participant of any official sponsor or supplier of the Event.

7.2 Any film, photographs (by camera or mobile phone), or any other recording of moving or still picture, and all intellectual property in connection therewith (including but not limited to copyright) shall remain the property of the Event Organiser, and where such intellectual property does not automatically vest in the Event Organiser, these Conditions shall constitute a legally binding assignment thereof and/or the Participant shall sign, or procure the signature of all reasonable documentation required to give affect thereto. Accordingly any such recording shall not be used other than for private use without the Event Organiser's prior written consent.

7.3 The Event Organiser will use reasonable endeavours to provide an Event finish time for the Participant however it cannot be held responsible for any computer result anomalies or any technical malfunctions.

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7.4. The Event Organiser will contact you from time to time about the Event and related activity. Your details will also be passed onto the official Event Photographers in order for them to email you regarding your photo's after the race – they will not contact you about anything other than your Event photo. The Event Organiser will not pass your details onto any other third parties without your prior consent.

8. General

8.1 These Conditions (and the documents referred to herein) constitute the entire agreement and understanding of the parties and supersede any previous agreement between the parties relating to the Event. The Participant acknowledges and agrees that in submitting the Entry Form (and the documents referred to herein) it does not rely on, and shall have no remedy in respect of, any statement, representation, warranty, understanding, promise or assurance (whether negligently or innocently made) of any person (whether party to these Conditions or not) other than as expressly set out in these Conditions.

8.2 Nothing in these Conditions shall constitute or be deemed to constitute a partnership between the parties hereto or constitute or be deemed to constitute either party as agent of the other for any purpose whatsoever and neither party shall have authority or power to bind the other or to contract in the name of the other in any way or for any purpose.

8.3 No waiver by either party of a breach or a default hereunder shall be effective unless in writing and signed by both parties and any such waiver shall not be deemed to be a waiver of any subsequent breach or default of the same or similar nature.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

8.4 To the extent permitted by law all provisions of these Conditions shall be severable and no provision shall be affected by the invalidity or unenforceability of any other provision with the remaining provisions if necessary, being so amended as shall be necessary to give effect to the spirit of these Conditions so far as possible.

8.5 These Conditions shall be interpreted in accordance with the laws of England and Wales and any dispute arising hereunder shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English Courts.
